Gridiron Club of Greater Boston Announces 18 Semi-Finalists for 15th Annual Joe Concannon College Hockey Award

List includes 12 nominees from six nationally ranked Division II/III teams in New England

BOSTON – February 9, 2015 – <u>Gridiron Club of Greater Boston</u> president Bob Norton announced today that 18 student-athletes are semi-finalists for the fifteenth <u>Joe Concannon Award</u>, presented annually to the best American-born college hockey player in New England at the NCAA Division II/III level.

This year's list comprises nine forwards, five offensively talented defensemen and four exceptional goaltenders. The candidates include eight players from the NESCAC conference, six from the ECAC East conference, three from the ECAC Northeast and one from the NE-10 Conference.

Twelve of this year's semifinalists are members of nationally ranked teams. They include, from the ECAC East, <u>Alec Thieda</u> (Rochester Hills, MI) and <u>Dean Niezgoda</u> (Brewster, MA) from number-one-ranked Norwich University; <u>Jamie Murray</u> (Scituate, MA) and <u>Mike Vollmin</u> (Wilmington, NC) from Babson College; <u>Stephen Buco</u> (North Providence, RI) and <u>Michael Kuhn</u> (Holbrook, MA) from Massachusetts-Boston.

The semifinalists from ranked NESCAC teams are <u>Sean Dougherty</u> (Smithtown, NY) and <u>Craig Kitto</u> (Ashburn, VA) from Williams College; <u>Aaron Deutsch</u> (Lloyd Harbor, NY) from Amherst College; and last season's Joe Concannon Award winner, <u>Jackson Brewer</u> (Newton, MA), along with teammates <u>Michael Flynn</u> (Cheshire, CY) and <u>Ryan Cole</u> (Anchorage, AK) from Trinity College.

Two more NESCAC institutions are represented with worthy nominees. Sophomore **EJ Rauseo** (Methuen, MA) leads the Mules of Colby College in scoring and has provided great team leadership. The final NESCAC nominee is senior **Connor Quinn** (Sudbury, MA), who leads Bowdoin College in scoring.

Two goaltenders and one offense-minded defenseman represent the ECAC Northeast Conference. Junior defenseman Alex Pompeo (Hingham, MA) has been a great addition to the Salve Regina squad posting seven goals and 17 points so far this season. Sophomore goalie Joey Ballmer (Kalamazoo, MI) is another repeat nominee carrying a .935 save percentage and 1.88 goals-against average for Johnson and Wales University. Junior Alex Larson (Madison, AL) of the Nichols College Bison ranks among the nation's top goaltenders. He has 13 wins, a .953 save percentage, and a 1.68 goals-against average.

From NCAA Division II ranks and the Northeast-10 Conference is junior forward <u>Joe Collins</u> (Mansfield, MA) of Southern New Hampshire University. His 38 points to date lead the scoring parade for the Penmen, who are seeking to repeat as NE-10 champions.

"This cadre of 18 semifinalists is the largest group we have ever included for consideration," said Gridiron Club Hockey Awards Committee chairman Tim Costello. "This list reflects the high level of play and talent found across the conferences in New England. Our committee believes that the level of play merited increasing the number of players for consideration. As is the case each season, it will definitely be a challenge for the committee to pick the winner from the players nominated."

The Gridiron Club plans to announce the finalists and winner of the 15th Joe Concannon Award in March, prior to the start of NCAA Frozen Four Tournament play and present the award during the New England Hockey Writers dinner in April.

The Joe Concannon Award

The Gridiron Club established the Joe Concannon Award in 2001 to honor Joe, a lifelong devotee of college hockey, former member of the Walter Brown Award Selection Committee and, as a journalist, a staunch advocate for the amateur athletes he knew and covered. A native of Litchfield, Connecticut, Joe graduated from Boston University in 1961. He served as sports information director (SID) at Holy Cross before joining the *Boston Globe in* the late 1960's to cover college sports. Joe declined frequent invitations by his editors to write about Boston's major professional sports teams, preferring to concentrate on the colleges, distance running and golf. He wrote the book *Marathoning with Bill Rodgers* and established the highly successful Litchfield Road Race in his hometown. Joe was a world traveler and was especially proud of his Irish heritage, frequently sojourning to the Emerald Isle. He passed away in 2000.
